PERSONAL TRANSPORT VEHICLES

CLASSIFICATIONS

PERSONAL TRANSPORT VEHICLE (PTV)

- Designed for short-distance travel
- Typically constructed to achieve speeds of up to 20 MPH
- Allowed on specified city streets, trails, and parking zones
- Authorized streets: 25 MPH or lower

LOW SPEED VEHICLE (LSV)

- Operating speed engineered between 20–25 MPH
- Suitable for streets with a posted speed limit of 25 MPH or lower
- Approved for use on city trails

MULTIPURPOSE OFF-HIGHWAY VEHICLE (MPOHV)

- Primarily designed for work or off-road applications
- May achieve higher speeds based on design
- Authorized for use on designated streets only
- Not allowed on trails

REGISTRATION REQUIRED

- Registration with the Acworth Police Department
- Application must include:
 - Proof of ownership
 - Valid driver's license
 - Vehicle make, model, and VIN
 - Proof of insurance
- Registration fee required
- Registration decal must be properly displayed

GEORGIA TAG REQUIRED



Low-Speed Vehicles (LSVs) and Multipurpose Off-Highway Vehicles (MPOHVs) must be registered and tagged through the Cobb County Tag Office.
